Thank you to those who showed support of my Guatemala mission trip that I took in March. IT is with excitement that I share with you that together we raised \$950! That almost covered the cost of 4 stoves! This mission trip was a record setting year. Some of the accomplishments include:

- 150 homes with plancha stove/water filters
- 1 community school with an institutional stove and 10 water filters
- 1,139 people impacted with healthier living
- 1,800 trees saved each year for the life of the stove
- 156 hours saved each year for the life of the stove due to the efficiency of the stove

The medical team also completed 1,744 medical procedures during the trip.

It was a truly rewarding trip in so many ways and I look forward to making the trip again next year. If anyone is interested in joining me, please let me know and I will get you the necessary information.
