MESSAGE FROM OUR SENIOR MINISTER, REV. JACOB THORNE

Dear Community,

As our liturgy proclaimed on Pentecost morning, we have transitioned from being an "Easter People" to being a "Pentecost People." In essence, being a "Pentecost People" means that the same Spirit that gave birth to Jesus, empowered the Apostles, and inspired Paul's preaching is now breathing and working through us, so that the presence of God can be born anew. The Spirit of God moves from one generation to the next.

But what happens when we don't always feel the Spirit? What if we begin to have doubts about our faith? Does this mean we can't be "Pentecost People"?

Starting this Sunday, I will begin a new sermon series that aims to answer these questions. Based on Adam Hamilton's latest book, "Wrestling with Doubt, Finding Faith," we will explore the following six questions and topics:

- Does God exist?
- 2. The trouble with the Bible
- 3. Do non-Christians go to Heaven?
- 4. Does Heaven really exist?
- 5. Unanswered prayers.
- 6. Why do innocent people suffer?

This series is designed to help us navigate our doubts and strengthen our faith, reminding us that questioning is a natural part of spiritual growth. I invite you to join us on this journey of exploration and discovery as we seek to deepen our understanding and connection with God.

Bottle Caps to Benches

The Mission Team is starting a new project. We will be collecting plastic bottle caps and product lids.

These will be given to an organization which takes the plastic bottle caps and lids and recycles them into benches and picnic tables.

A box is in the Mission corner of the narthex, where you can place your clean and dry plastic bottle caps & lids.

Here are the types of lids and caps needed:

- 1. Drink bottle caps (soda, water, milk, sports drinks, orange juice, etc.)
- 2. Flip top and spout caps (ketchup, mustard)
- 3. Kids' snack pouches (applesauce, yogurt)
- 4. Detergent caps
- 5. Hairspray caps
- 6. Spray paint caps
- 7. Medicine or pill bottle caps
- 8. Shampoo/conditioner caps
- 9. Deodorant caps
- 10. Coffee can lids, peanut butter, cream cheese, Cool Whip, mayonnaise lids, etc.

Remember, we want only caps and lids, no bottles.

Thanks for your help in keeping these plastic items out of landfills and our oceans.
