MESSAGE FROM OUR SENIOR MINISTER, REV. JACOB THORNE

Dear Community,

Have you noticed? This year, everything appears to be happening sooner than expected: Warmer days have arrived earlier, our lawns demanded their first trim ahead of time, and daffodils have bloomed prematurely. Even Easter has greeted us sooner. Yet, amidst this acceleration, certain pillars of our tradition stand unwavering: Our Maundy Thursday service, our Prayer Vigil, the celebration of Easter Sunday, and the forthcoming proclamation that Christ has indeed risen. These observances remind us that, despite the ever-changing seasons, the steadfastness of God's presence endures.

So, where do we find this unwavering constancy?

Richard Rohr, a renowned writer, priest, and theologian, offers insight through a personal anecdote. While trekking down a trail from his hermitage, Rohr encountered a reclusive monk, known for his solitude, who surprisingly recognized him and offered a profound message: "Richard, when you're out there preaching, just tell the people one thing. God is not 'out there.' (He gestured towards the sky) God bless you." This brief interaction left a lasting impression, emphasizing that God's presence is not distant but interwoven within the fabric of our daily lives and the natural world around us.

This Easter, our message will highlight that the essence of Jesus' presence represents both a renewal and a perennial truth within our lives. It's a call to recognize the divine not as a distant entity but as an intimate part of our everyday experiences and transformations.

I eagerly anticipate joining you in worship this Sunday as we celebrate the Good News of Easter morning.
